George Packard's book Protest in Tokyo is the definitive account of the negotiations and political crisis surrounding the 1960 US-Japan security treaty. Dr. Packard, currently the President of the United States-Japan Foundation and past Dean of SAIS, has written an article in the March-April 2010 issue of Foreign Affairs magazine ("The United States-Japan Security Treaty at 50: Still a Grand Bargain?") that reviews the past 50 years of our security relationship and calls for Washington and Tokyo to "engage in a deliberate reconsideration of the entire range of issues raised by the security treaty," including force levels, the Marine presence in Okinawa, host nation support, and the status of forces agreement.

Following Dr Packard's presentation, Koji Murata, Professor of Political Science at Doshisha University, will present a Japanese perspective on the future of the US-Japan security relationship. Professor Murata's specialties include the history of the US-Japan alliance and Japanese foreign policy.
